AUC Woodruff Library Unveils New Building Access Procedures, Announces 2010 Fall Semester Hours of Operation

Beginning on the first day of classes, Wednesday, August 25, Atlanta University Center (AUC) students, faculty and staff can “slide” their way into the Atlanta University Center Robert W. Woodruff Library.

A quick slide of your **VALID AUC ID** card in the Library’s new electronic card reader at the entrance turnstile and building access is immediately granted. During mid-term and final exam periods when the Library offers 24-hour access, students, faculty and staff will also have to slide their ID through a card reader on the Library’s exterior door for late night building entry.

The card reader system was installed as part of the AUC Woodruff Library’s Phase I Renovation completed in May. Nearly three years in the making, the card reader technology is designed to read IDs from each AUC school—Clark Atlanta University, the Interdenominational Theological Center, Morehouse College and Spelman College.
