“Brawley Bounce” Pick-Up Service Extended through Spring 2010

In response to the success of the fall pilot program, the “Brawley Bounce” golf cart pick-up and drop-off service is now in service through Spring Semester 2010.

The “Bounce” was piloted for a total of six weeks (October 5-November 13, 2009) this past fall. But its success was evident in only four full weeks of service, when more than 5,000 members of the Atlanta University Center (AUC) community were safely transported to Promenade destinations! As a result, the service was extended through the entire fall semester and resumed when spring classes began on January 13.

A few details about the “Brawley Bounce” golf cart service...

- Operates Sunday-Thursday, 5:00 PM-12:30 AM (around midnight)
- Transports AUC students, faculty and staff to any location along the AUC Promenade between Martin Luther King Jr. Drive and Greensferry Avenue
- Can transport up to three passengers at one time
