



Using NetLibrary

The Robert W. Woodruff Library provides access to approximately 42,000 electronic books (eBooks) and 1,400 electronic audio books (eAudiobooks) from NetLibrary.

Atlanta University Center (AUC) faculty, staff and students can read these eBooks and listen to eAudiobooks online over the WWW.

Find NetLibrary titles

- The [Robert W. Woodruff Library Catalog](#) lists all of the NetLibrary titles available and provides easy-to-use hyperlinks to each title within NetLibrary
 - From within the Library's Catalog, you can retrieve records for NetLibrary eBooks and eAudiobooks by adding the keyword "**netlibrary**" to any keyword, author, title, or subject heading search.
- Patrons may also access NetLibrary titles by using the [NetLibrary Link](#) under the section entitled **Finding Books** on the Library's homepage

Read online

Once you have found a NetLibrary title you are interested in you can view the full text online. After 15 minutes of inactivity (not touching your keyboard, not moving forward or backward in the eBook, etc.) your NetLibrary session will automatically time out and you will be returned to the NetLibrary homepage.

NetLibrary does not support any kind of "offline" viewing or "checking out" of eBook titles.

Print and copy

NetLibrary allows you to print one page at a time from an eBook. You can print the page you are viewing by clicking the Print icon in the Adobe Acrobat toolbar, or using the print function in your browser.

NetLibrary allows you to copy selections of text from the page you are viewing by using the "Select" tool in the Adobe Acrobat toolbar, or the copy function in your browser.

Printing all of an eBook title violates copyright laws. If a suspicious usage pattern indicating excessive printing or copying is detected, the activity is logged and you are sent a copyright warning message.

Create account for Favorites and Notes

All AUC faculty, staff or students can create a NetLibrary account which will allow you to add NetLibrary books to a list of your favorites and enter online notes about those books on the NetLibrary site.

- Select "Create a Free account"
- Provide the required information
- Click on "Create Account"
