## **RWWL 24-Hour Operations Offered for Spring Final Exam Period**

*Monday-Friday, April 27-May 1 and Sunday-Friday, May 3-8*

Even in the midst of preparations for its upcoming interior renovation, the Robert W. Woodruff Library of the Atlanta University Center will provide 24-hour access and extended hours during the spring 2009 final exam period. Beginning Monday, April 27, exam period library access will be as follows:

### ***Monday, April 27 – Friday, May 1, 2009***

Open 7:30 AM Monday – Close Midnight Friday

### ***Saturday, May 2, 2009***

Open Noon – Close Midnight

### ***Sunday, May 3– Friday May 8, 2008***

Open Noon Sunday – Close 6 PM Friday

During 24-hour operations, users may expect the following:

- ▶ After 7:00 p.m., a valid AUC identification card is required to enter and remain in the building. Users will not be admitted without valid AUC ID.
- ▶ Service desks will be staffed until 1:00 a.m. From 1:00-8:00 a.m., only user-initiated Library services will be available, including:
  - Quiet study
  - Access to the Library's electronic resources and online catalog
  - The ability to place interlibrary loan requests online
  - The ability to check one's circulation record online
  - Internet access
  - Word processing
  - Copying and printing
- ▶ Regular shuttle service will be available until 12:30 a.m. From 12:30 a.m.-7:30 a.m., a one-way shuttle will be available to transport students from the Library to the campuses.
