TRANSFORMATION STATION

1. What is “Transformation Station”?

“Transformation Station” is a three-week showcase (February 17-March 6) featuring furniture options that reflect the functional and aesthetic environment planned for the renovated Library.

2. What is its purpose?

The “Transformation Station” showcase provides an opportunity for AUC students, faculty and staff to view and provide feedback on the design, function and suitability of displayed furniture options.

3. What’s included in the “Transformation Station” display?

- Collaborative Workstation
- Computer/Classroom Chairs
- Lounge Chairs
- Café Chairs
- Work/Study Tables
- Whiteboards

4. Are these the exact styles, fabrics and colors planned for the renovated Woodruff Library?

The styles, colors and fabrics displayed in Transformation Station ARE NOT representative of those under consideration for the renovated space.

5. How do we give our feedback?

Feedback can be provided in three ways:

- a. *A hard copy survey* listing each item within the display. Visitors can give “Like”/“Don’t Like” feedback on each item by checking one of the two options corresponding to the item’s assigned number.
- b. *An electronic survey* is available on a computer set up on the displayed Collaborative Workstation. Visitors can give “Like”/“Don’t Like” feedback on each item by checking one of the two options corresponding to the item’s assigned number.
- c. *“Comment” flip charts* set up by each furniture grouping allow visitors to give specific comments about any of the numbered items in the display.

6. How will my feedback be used?

Your feedback will help inform the Library’s decision making process when items are selected for purchase.
